

Vote now for the Best License Plate of 2004. Here are the Top 10 nominees, including the four new general issues introduced last year, plus six optional plates from across the USA and Canada. New this year is a weighted voting system. Instead of selecting just one plate as the best of 2004, you are asked to rank your three favorite plates, starting with \#1 (your favorite). When tabulating the votes, a weighted score will be given to each ranking as follows: \#1 = 10 points; \#2 = 6 points and \#3 = 3 points. The plate with the most points at the end of the voting will be named ALPCA's Best New Plate of 2004. This is similar to the system used to select MVP and Cy Young winners in baseball.

You must vote by March 4, 2005. Please use the ballot enclosed in this issue, or send an e-mail message to: alpcabestplate@yahoo. com with your three favorite plates in ranked order, also including your name and ALPCA membership number. Thank you to everyone who nominated plates for the contest this year and for taking part in this great ALPCA program!
